RESORT VILLAGE OF ISLANDVIEW BYLAW 4 - 2013

A BYLAW TO PROVIDE REGULATIONS FOR GOLF CARTS WITHIN VILLAGE LIMITS

THE COUNCIL OF THE RESORT VILLAGE OF ISLAND VIEW ENACTS THE FOLLOWING:

- 1. All golf carts must be registered with The Village prior to use within the Village as permitted in the Bylaws.
- 2. Golf carts will be given a registration number that must be prominently displayed on the front and back of the golf cart.
- 3. When registering the golf carts, owners must show, and prove liability insurance to the minimum of \$500,000.00 (five hundred thousand) per occurrence.
- 4. Upon registration, golf cart owners will be required to sign a liability waiver to hold the Village harmless of all liability resulting from the use of their golf carts.
- 5. A) Golf carts can be operated one- half hour before sunrise and one-half hour after sunset; and
 - B) Golf carts equipped with proper CSA golf cart approved front and back lights can be driven at any time.
- 6. All operators of golf carts must hold a valid government issued driver's license.
- 7. Council recommends that all golf carts have a proper first aid kit.
- 8. Golf carts shall be occupied by driver and as many riders as there are proper seats available for.
- 9. Contravention of any provision of this Bylaw may result in the imposition of a fine in accordance with Bylaw 2-2008 and /or revocation of a golf cart.
- 10. This Bylaw comes into effect on the date of signing.
- 11. Bylaw 2-2008 1(a)(vii) will be repealed.
