



BYLAW #12/94


A BYLAW TO REGULATE AND PROHIBIT THE DISCHARGE OF FIREARMS

The Council of the Resort Village of Island View in the Province of Saskatchewan enact as follows:

1. For the purpose of this bylaw the expression "municipality" shall mean the Resort Village of Island View.
2. Subject to section 3, no person shall discharge any gun or other firearm, air-gun or spring gun or any class or type thereof within the municipality.
3. The provisions of section 2 do not apply to a person who is:
 - (a) a police officer;
 - (b) a registered member of a gun club or similar organization while engaged in target practice at a recognized range.
 - (c) any person appointed by council to act as a pest control officer.
4. The Clerk of the Municipality is hereby authorized to issue a permit to a recognized gun club or similar organization who makes application for such permit stating specifically the intent of such club or organization and the location of the range along with a permit fee of \$20.00.
5. A person who contravenes the provisions of this bylaw is guilty of an offence and upon summary conviction shall be liable to the penalty provided for by the general penalty bylaw of the municipality.
