

Resort Village of Island View

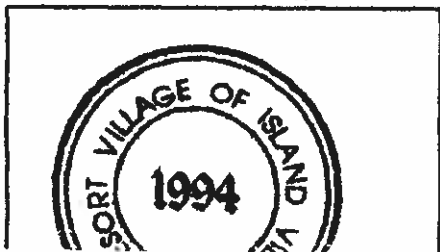
Bylaw # 1/99


The Council of the Resort village of Island View, in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

1. That a uniform system of numbering houses as shown on the attached map, which shall become part of this bylaw, shall be used in the Resort Village of Island View.
2. That all existing numbers of houses not now conforming with the provisions of this bylaw shall be changed to conform to the system herein adopted.
3. A separate number shall be assigned for each lot.
4. Each house shall bear the number assigned to the frontage on which the front entrance is situated.
5. Numerals indicating the official number of each house shall be posted in a manner as to be visible from the street on which the property is located.
6. The Clerk of the Resort Village of Island View shall be responsible for maintaining the numbering systems, and shall keep a record of all numbers assigned under this Bylaw.
7. Any person who contravenes the provisions of the Bylaw is guilty of an offence and upon conviction shall be liable to the penalty provided in the General Penalty Bylaw of the Resort Village of Island View.
8. Numerals must be placed on the house front by September 30, 1999.

This bylaw shall be called the **Uniform System for the Numbering of Houses**, and shall be **effective as of January 23, 1999**.
