- Warren Coghlan reviewed the SGI guidelines – 16 year olds only allowed for drivers, or a learners with an adult. He stated someone is going to get hurt. Marine Drive will be equipped with more speed signs and children playing signs. The way the ATV's and Golf Carts have been driven is dangerous, Council doesn't want to ban the permits to have them. It is also all residents responsibilities to say something RCMP \$100 fine with no driver's license, and impounding of the vehicle. W. Mishak – suggested a mailout to all the residents – mentioning fines and age for driving with a link to SGI. Council agreed and suggested it should go on the Website too. And, it should address both ATVs and Golf Carts. ATV's do issues a special license for under 16 drivers.
